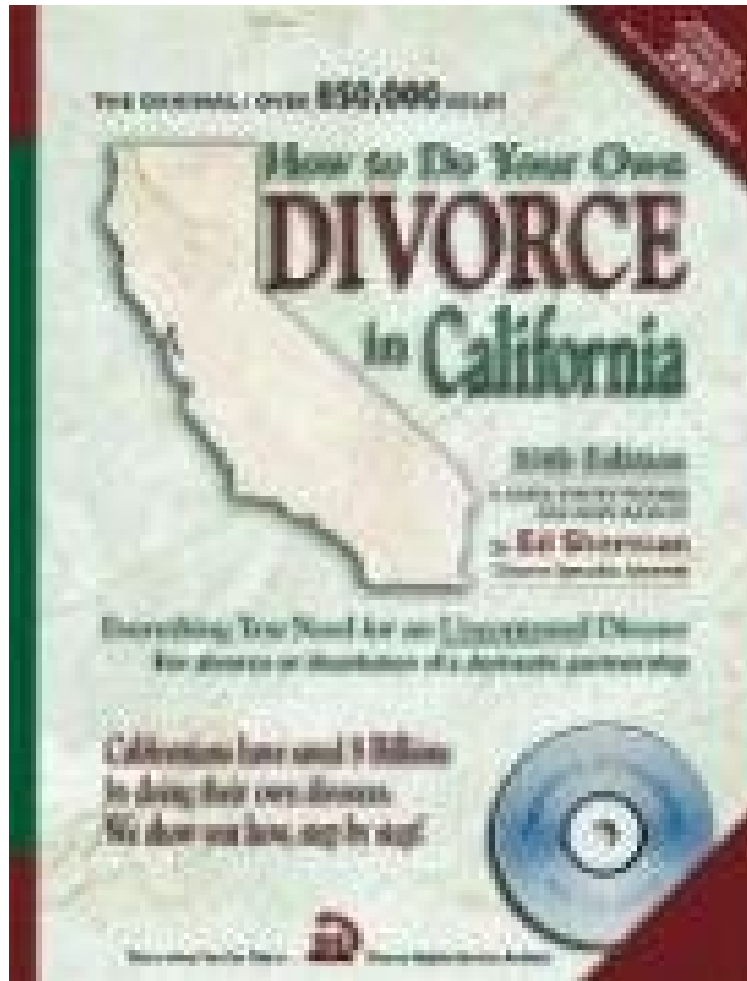

It's value is in the description of the process and perhaps as importantly the outcome of various situations.Not sure if it is still available but there was a law firm associated with

the publisher which offered couples legal counseling during the process at a nominal cost. The great value was they given a set of facts they would outline the minimum and maximum the court would award for any contested items. It was instantly obvious to all that the cost of the contest was far greater than the difference in probable outcomes and thus a spirit of compromise was encouraged. They will also complete and file the forms for you at a nominal cost. Highly recommended. Yes, lawyers get divorced just like everyone else. My divorce was not contested, but the mechanics of dividing and transferring pension funds required either a family law attorney (\$1500 minimum) or an assist from a knowledgeable person. I was a little disappointed when I found the part about dividing pension funds and it said the issue was beyond the scope of the book, since that was the only reason I bought it. But the rest of it was simple and straightforward and not yet out of date. I found out elsewhere that IRA administrators do not need to be joined as parties iff they say they will abide by a certified copy of a divorce order.
