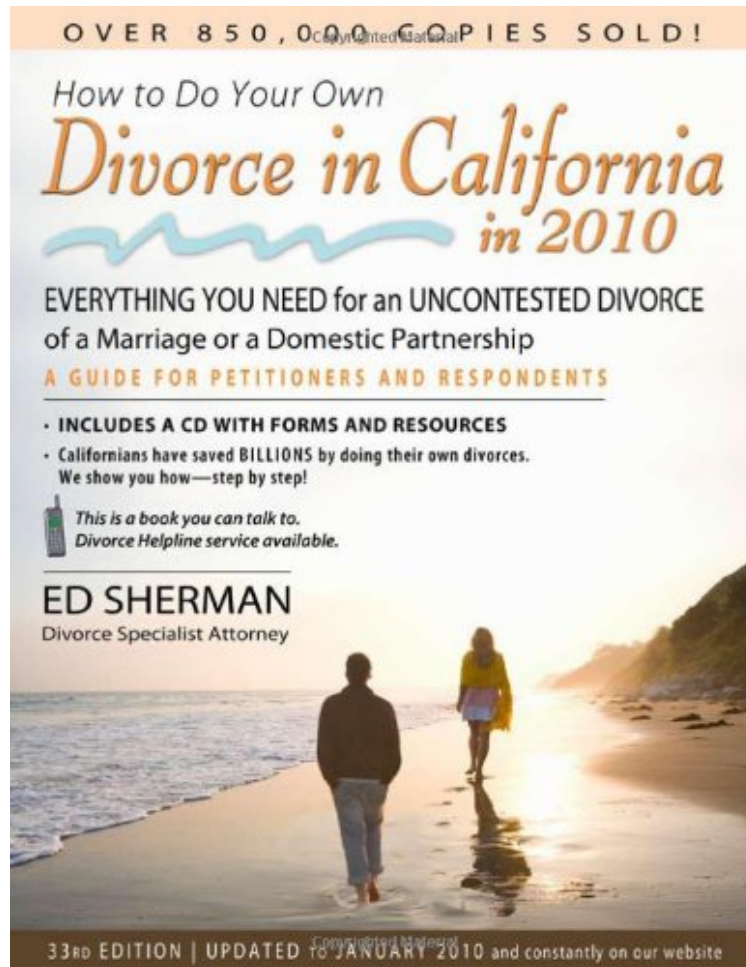

The advice all sounds plausible but is not always current and accurate. For example, they got the address of the court wrong! They do not tell

you the best way to do things, and do not cover some very common scenarios, like how one spouse can hand over the residence to the other as part of the settlement. I suppose you are meant to buy the sequel. It really bothers me that they date stamp the cover of each book and make like you always need the current year. Not so. I looked at previous and later years and they are the same. It's just a way of selling more new books and making the old ones worthless. That said, the process of getting a divorce is so horribly expensive that the cost of this book and ones like it are relatively trivial. So, why not buy a copy and get some idea of what you are headed into. Or sit down in the library and work through theirs. The book comes with a CD of supplemental information including forms and calculators, which are nice to have, even though online versions are free and current. I ended up happening upon a truly great paralegal who knew all the logistics of how it is actually done. Didn't need a lawyer because we agreed on terms of separation.
