Illustrated Patent Drawing Standards by Murray Henderson definitely fulfills this need. The book covers drawing requirements for both the United States Patent and Trademark Office (USPTO) and Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT) applications.The author goes step by step through the Federal Rules and PCT rules that govern drawing standards giving an ample number of sample drawings illustrating each point. There are also sidebars called "Author's Comments" where the author will give his own unique perspective or tip on the drawing rule or sample illustration. The sections on preparing drawings PCT applications are very helpful and hard to find elsewhere.The book contains a generous helping of practical tips. For example, the

author goes into great detail on properly preparing the PDF drawings for electronic filing with the USPTO. The author also provides a great outline of the drawing examination process along with an accompanying flow chart. I have two minor criticisms of the book. First, some of the references need to be updated for example, there is a reference to an old version of the Manual of Patent Examining Procedure (MPEP). The other was that I wish the author would have devoted a larger section of the book to design patent drawing practice.
