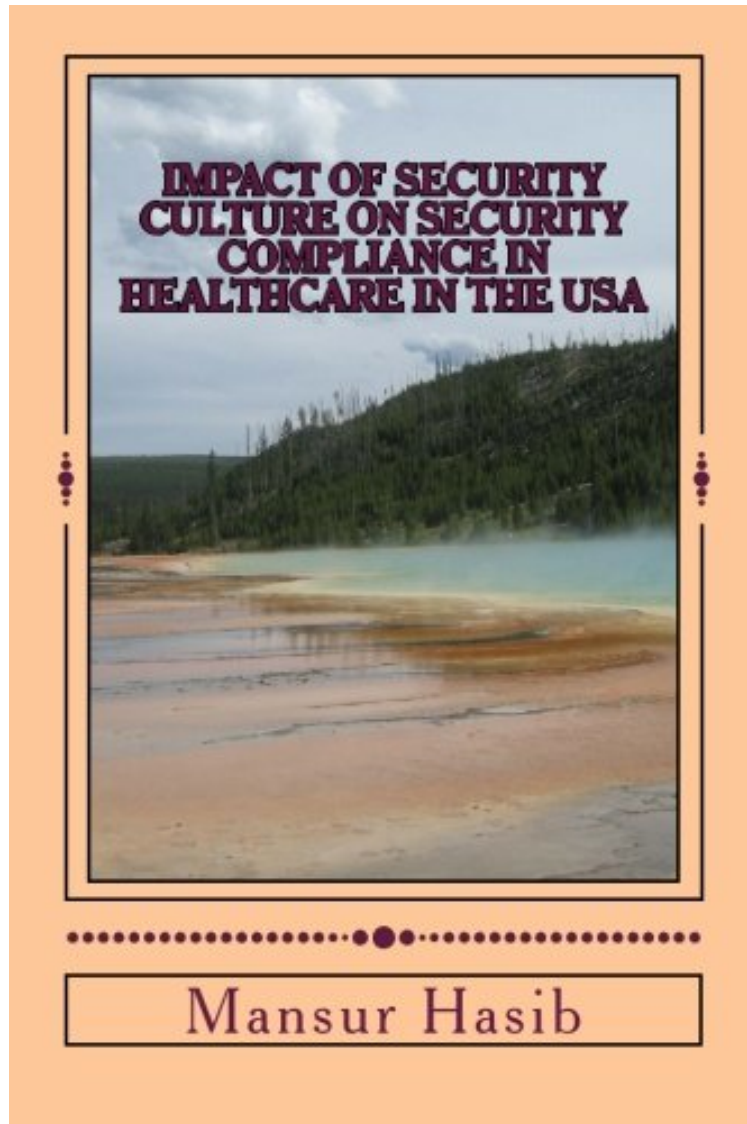

He did an outstanding job with providing a comprehensive and well-written scholarly work on a topic that is now very relevant to those of us that are in the healthcare space. Dr. Hasib did an excellent job in narrowing down the dependent and independent variables, ensuring that key demographics were included in the study, fully addressing the "people" factor that is so important to information security adoption, and focusing the sample respondents largely to Chief Information Officers and Chief Information Security Officers. This allowed us to hear things directly from those that are the most involved and knowledgeable in this area.
