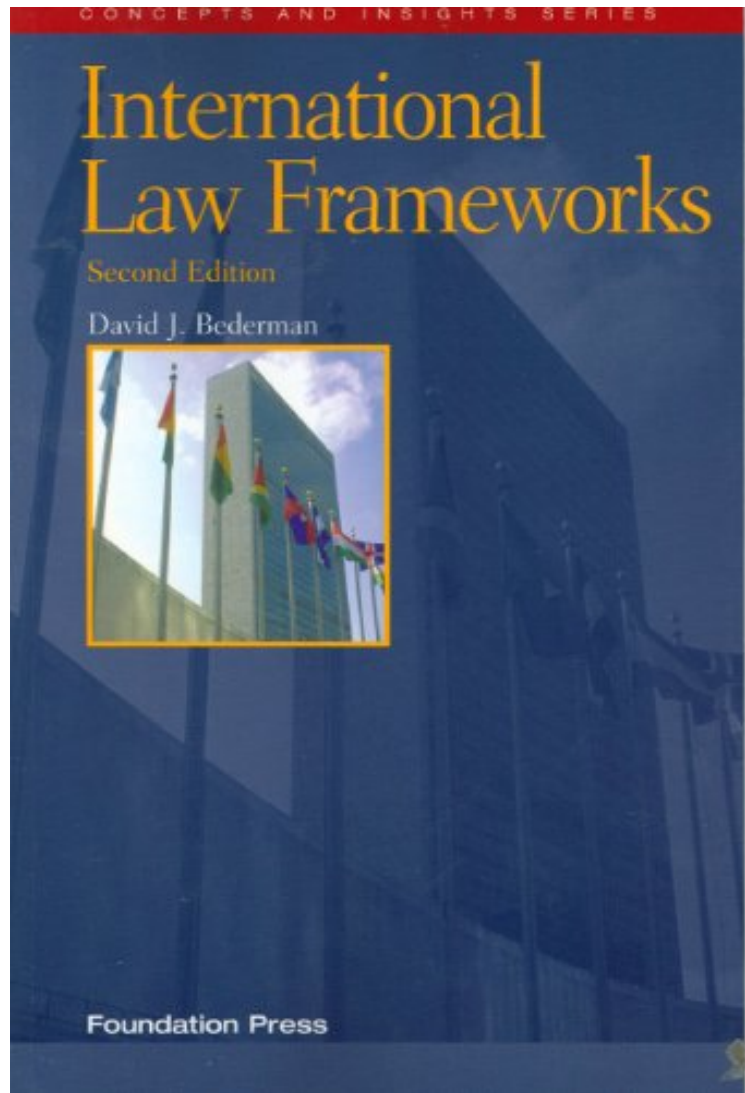

You can easily read this with no background in international law, yet I would caution you that, as this is thematic and introductory, do not expect to get in-depth case studies or in-depth analysis of various facets of international law. I do recommend this as an introduction, however, because it covers the important facets of international law, including a chapter on international law's development. Present are chapters on

the law of the sea, war crimes, jurisdiction, and others. The chapters are typically concise, giving you only the information you need while often citing court cases relevant to the particular branch of law. On the whole, do purchase this if you want an excellent introduction, yet if you are looking for more in-depth analysis I would recommend supplementing this work with additional material.
