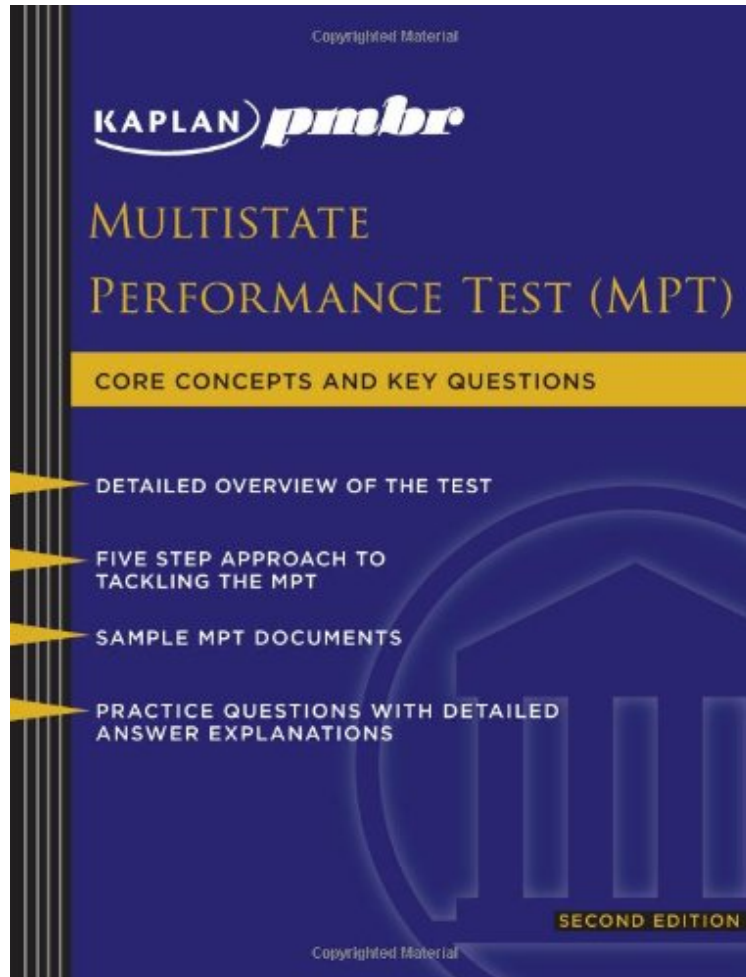

It consists of two 90-minute sections with questions covering: legal analysis, fact analysis, problem solving, resolution of ethical dilemmas, organization and management of a law firm, and communication. The MPT is administered on the Tuesday before the last Wednesday in February and July of each year. How does the MPT differ from the Multistate Essay Exam (MEE)? On the MPT, test takers write like a lawyer, outlining the key issues and making recommendations to your client. On the Essay Exam, they write like a law student, using IRAC and exploring various possible conclusions and/or courses of action. On the MPT, they limit the answer to the specific question asked.
