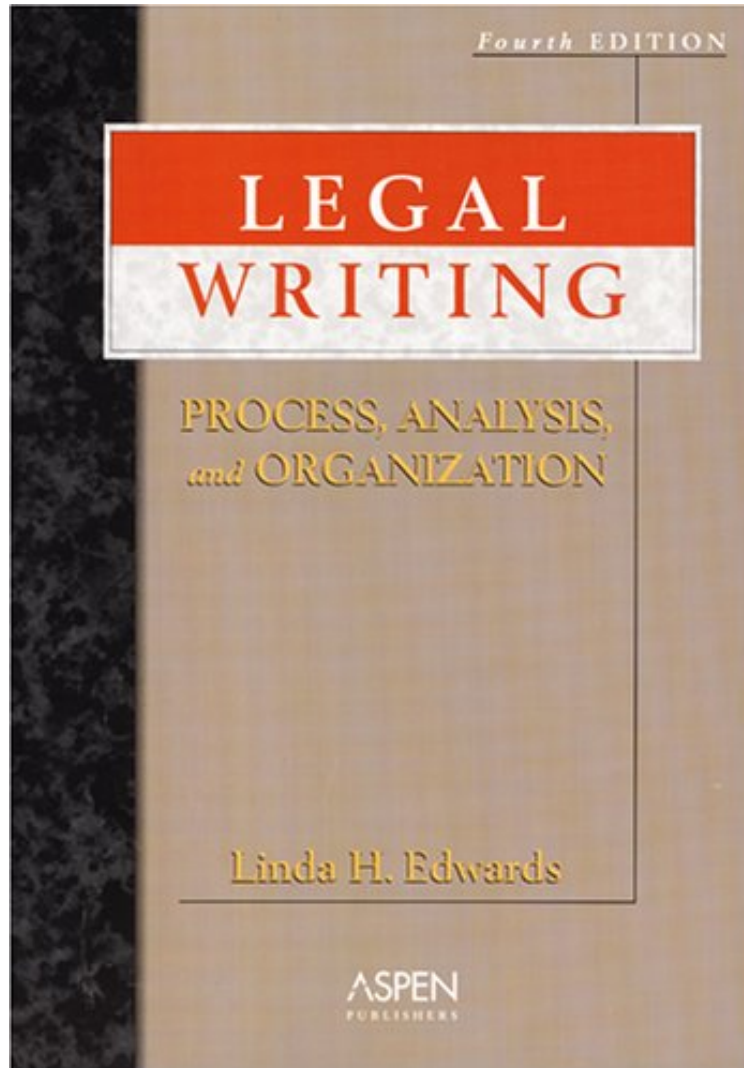

Pure TortureBy MattThe problem with this book is that she is constantly telling you to write special little paragraphs with little or no explanation or reason for their existence. Instead of telling you how to write a paper, she tells you all kinds of "specialty paragraphs" that you must include in your paper.For example, here's what she says should be in the "analysis section" of a trial brief (remember this is just part of a brief):1) An Umbrella

section containing a rule summary and controlling authority and rule definition and principles affecting the rule application and argument summary and resolution of potential "resistance")²) A Standard paradigm (don't ask what it is or why she calls it that)³) A rule statement with two sub-parts⁴) A rule explanation with four sub-parts⁵) A "factual conclusion" with a conclusion two sections before your actual conclusion⁶) A rule application with three sub-parts⁷) A conclusion with two sub-parts
