It is more than just a Long Term Care Guide, and it offers information far beyond essential tips. It is a well written, easy to understand guide, put together by a group of professionals. I am a caregiver, and have encountered many unexpected obstacles that might have been avoided had I read this book earlier. Buy this book, and consider it a primer on elder care. It clarifies many of the vague, foggy terms that can cost big bucks if you fail to understand them. As a quick example, we purchased an excellent Long Term Care policy in 1982. That policy refers only to Long term Care and Nursing Homes. Today those terms on such a policy may or may not include skilled nursing, intermediate custodial care, assisted living, personal care, or continuing care. It pays to get ahead of the game before the need becomes a crisis. This book addresses specifically the common mistakes with regard to elder care, and explains what to do about them. Keystone Elder Care, P.C. is a Pennsylvania firm, but the information in the publication provides a superb springboard for elder care planning in any state. The authors are clear when they address an issue that may be different in a state other than Pennsylvania. Even then, they have the readers attention and might avoid a critical oversight.
